



Apnea Research protocol

In the setting of the AIDA apnea World championship we want to study the changes in cardiac rhythm in man during underwater submersion by ECG telemetry. This study will take place between the 25/11 at 6/12.

The aim of this work is to study modifications of electrocardiographic aspect during an apnea in constant weight. For that, a Holter (electrocardiogram device: EKG) will be placed in a waterproof chamber and fixed in the back of the free diver. It will record in continuous (before, during and after the diving) electrocardiographic tracing (EKG) with surface electrode. We only ask for one dive to the freediver and let's let free the wanted depth. All information will be confidential and you will receive personal analyses few months after the World Championship.
