Dr. Steven Kajiura



Florida divers are encountering sharks in record numbers yet worldwide shark populations are in peril. Dr. Kajiura will present on shark conservation and his activities in the field including tagging and monitoring. Dr. Kajiura will provide insight into Florida's shark migrations including why sharks arrive in our waters in such high numbers and which species are present. Dr. Kajiura's research focuses on the functional morphology and sensory biology of fishes, primarily elasmobranchs. This is a fabulous opportunity to understand the electro-sensory system of sharks, which they use to probe everything they encounter including divers. Don't miss this rare opportunity to ask questions of this renowned expert.



Anthony Segrich will present on diving and spear-fishing and photography in close proximity to sharks. His unique perspective and understanding is borne from very close encounters including tagging of sharks both in the water and on the boat and through commercial spear-fishing. In April of 2011 Anthony was spear-fishing in 190' of water when he was attacked by a massive Bull Shark. Anthony will discuss the day's events leading up to the point of the attack, what happened immediately before, during and after, and will provide his unique perspective on what the risks truly are.
